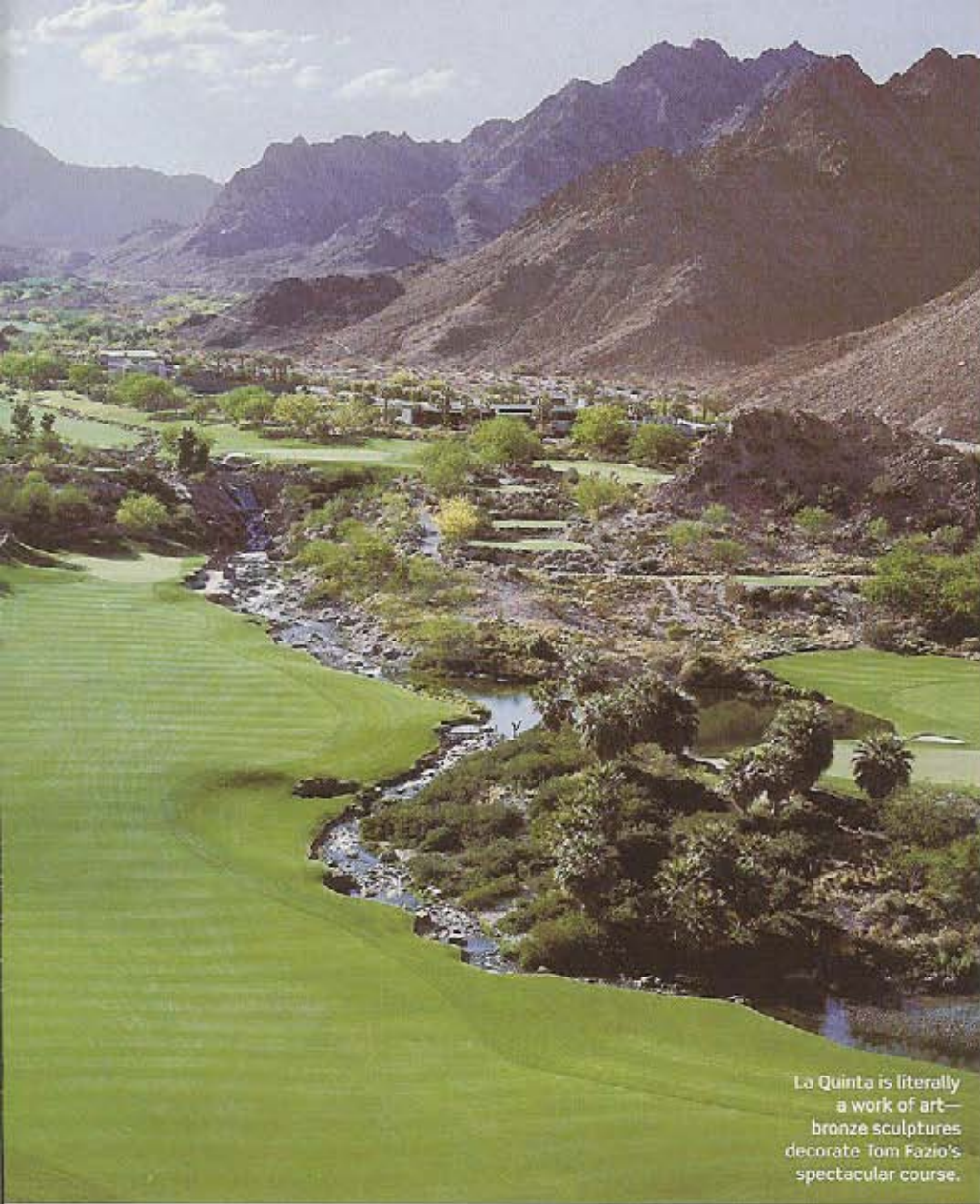

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The Quarry at La Quinta

LA QUINTA, CALIF.

When the private courses at PGA West in La Quinta got too "crowded" in the early 1990s, a small group of members formed the Quarry, which has taken its place among the best-conditioned and emptiest courses in the nation. The Quarry offers more diversity than a reality-TV show cast. One of the more unusual sights at this course is the bronze sculptures that depict early cowboy life, which are scattered in the rough. The lots, villas and estate homes ring the course perimeter only.

Set on 900 acres along the Kiawah River, Briar's Creek has only 100 home sites—none of them directly on the golf course. The first South Carolina course granted Silver Certification by Audubon International, it has no tee times and no unaccompanied guest play, so there's no stress for members who want to squeeze in an extra nine. Rees Jones gracefully blended forested holes with the occasional forced carry.
